## Ceiling Height Tricks Checklist

Use this checklist as a guide while designing or updating your space with standard ceiling heights:

[] Use light or white ceiling paint to visually lift the ceiling [] Paint crown molding and trim the same color as the walls for a seamless [] Use vertical stripes or tall wainscoting to draw the eye upward [] Avoid dark colors on the ceiling or walls if the room lacks natural light
Window Treatments
[] Mount curtains close to the ceiling (not just above the window frame) [] Use floor-to-ceiling drapery to emphasize height [] Choose pinch-pleated curtains for the structured vertical lines they create [] Avoid short or wide curtain rods - extend rods beyond the window frame
Wall Trim
[] Install vertical shiplap for subtle texture and height [] Use vertical board and batten to reinforce strong vertical lines [] Add panel moulding in tall, narrow rectangles to guide the eye upward
Furniture & Decor
[] Choose low-profile furniture to increase perceived ceiling height [] Hang tall mirrors or vertical art to elongate the space visually [] Use bookshelves or built-ins that go all the way up to the ceiling [] Keep clutter off the tops of cabinets to reduce visual crowding
Lighting

## **General Tips**

Color & Paint

[] Keep the ceiling free of unnecessary texture or visual breaks

[] Use semi-flush or recessed lighting instead of bulky fixtures

[] Add wall sconces or floor lamps to pull the eye upward[] Consider uplighting to bounce light off the ceiling

- [] Use consistent trim heights across rooms for flow
- [] Emphasize vertical lines wherever possible
